UBC online application: opening soon

UBC's 2021/22 online application will be opening at the end of September. We recommend that you and your students visit our <u>how to apply</u> page for an overview of the application process, and our <u>Personal Profile</u> page for tips on writing a strong Personal Profile.

Language 11 requirement: Vancouver campus

Applicants to UBC's Vancouver campus are required to have a Grade 11 language in addition to English. Students who entered the BC or Yukon school system after Grade 9 can have this requirement waived if their school counsellor or principal submits a written request on their behalf.

Transfer standing, external language certificates, and external language assessments granted at the Grade 11 level may also be used to meet the language 11 requirement.
